Jonathan set the world record for triple jump in 1995. Unbelievably, it's a record which he still holds more than two decades later, having collected every possible title. Indeed, Jonathan's Olympic gold medal in Sydney in 2000 was one of the crowning glories for one of Great Britain's greatest ever athletes.

Now recognised as one of the most accomplished lead broadcasters, presenters and corporate hosts, Jonathan has taken the stage countless times across a wide range of media events and corporate engagements. He is a commissioned representative of the International Olympic Committee and his credits include roles as lead presenter Eurosport, BBC and Channel 4.
