As one of the senior members of a very young Team GB 4 x 100m relay team, Asha has further success in her sights, starting with the World Athletics Championships in London later this year and a Gold medal in the 2018 Commonwealth Games.

With a degree in Drama from Kingston University, she is a natural performer and engaging speaker with an infectious energy, who is able to give the perspective of both a current Team GB athlete and senior member of the athletics team. She is committed to continuing her work within schools.
